Internship requirements:

- Commitment of at least 6 months
- Ability to work 10-15 hours a week, typically between the hours of 10am and 4pm Tuesday through Thursday, with some remote work time available.
- Ability to work in an office environment and lift 25lbs

- Computer literate (Microsoft Word & Excel, Gmail, Google Drive)
- Communications, journalism or some sort of writing background and experience
- Able to take direction well
- Ability research and report on assigned topics
- Clear and concise writing skills
- Able to communicate well with ECOSLO Board members and community members involved in various topics
- Self-motivated
- Responsible and organized
- Reliable transportation

- Familiarity with media outlets and social media sites. Experience in professional online posting preferred.
