hand soap, dishwashing, laundry detergent bottles, and shampoo bottles (remove pumps- these go in the trash)

Remember, only plastics #1 and #2



shampoo, face wash, toothpaste tubes

tin foil (rinse it first!)

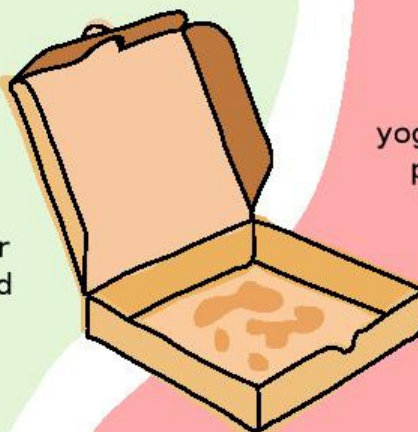


frozen food trays (only the tray, peel-away plastic goes in the bin!)



tissue boxes (remove the plastic insert and make sure there are no tissues left!)

clean pizza box/paper plates can be recycled



yogurt, hummus, hard plastic containers



glass bottle



dirty pizza box/paper plates go in the trash



takeaway cutlery



plastic bottle



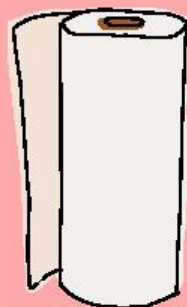
broken glass
